All applications to the First Year Grouping Balbriggan Community College will only be accepted from the 01/10/2026 at 9am and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 22/10/2026 at 9am. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All transfer applications to the Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth or Sixth Year Groups in Balbriggan Community College will only be accepted from the 17/05/27 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 04/06/27. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy. Equally, any transfer applications received during the current academic year, i.e. before June 2027, to transfer into a year group immediately, will be treated as a late application where the application window for transferring into the school for the academic year 2026/2027 took place during the previous academic year and anyone who did not receive a place at that time was put on a waiting list. Therefore,

any available places that arise in that year group during the 2026/2027 academic year will be filled from that waiting list, until that list expires at the end of the academic year 2026/2027.

All applicants to the First-Year Group and/or Special Class for the following academic year will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	24/10/2026
Successful applicants to the First Year Group must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	07/11/2026
All transfer applications to the Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth or Sixth Year Groups for the following academic year will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	14/06/26
Successful transfer applications to the Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth or Sixth Year Groups, in the following academic year must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	28/06/2027
Note: Failure to accept an offer of admission before the relevant deadline set out above, or as stated on any letter of offer, may result in the offer being withdrawn. Other situations where the offer of admission may be withdrawn are set out in Balbriggan Community College's Admission Policy.
